

## **ART HISTORY STUDY SKILLS**

The following steps should be taken to ensure maximum returns on your course of study.....

1. Allocate regular times to study for the examination between NOW and the examination date.
2. Divide up the time equally between the four options you have studied.
3. Make decisions about which topics you have to revise to answer in the examination. Commit yourself to answering certain topics NOW.
4. Organise notes under the separate topics under each of the four options studied.
5. Organise the topic subtitles around the topic as a mind map. Test your recall of these.
6. Identify the key words for the topic. List these with their details.
7. Organise content from the manual as a mind map around the different topic checklist subtitles. Test your recall of these.
8. Look at past examination questions and identify which questions belong to each topic.
9. Use the review tasks provided for each topic to construct answers (section A). Write these out in full.
10. Apply the content points to key words using the device-effect-idea formula to make statements (Section B). Write these out in full.
11. After each session, identify weaknesses of knowledge or expression and seek help or clarification.
